The wording of the webpage on covid exam deferrals has changed. It is now explicitly acknowledged that if you need to defer a final exam due to covid, a medical note is not necessary, so if you, for instance, get covid + tonight and have a test tomorrow morning, do not feel pressure to attend sick because you have not provided documentation or communicated with student affairs yet. (I am checking with Mac SAO to see if they also align themselves with this new statement as well. The webpage is run by Enrolment services which manages requests for faculties of science and arts, so I will need to check with our student affairs office on this, maybe then, if it is clear that our SAO also goes by what Enrolment services, we can make an announcement to remind students that they shouldn't feel pressured to come to finals sick.
