## 3.1 MCSS Budget 2022-2023

Catherine Bertrand-Vachet (*VP Finance*) presented the budget. MCSS Budget 2022-2023.pptx

A discussion followed: As expected, both the Ceilidh bar and new Restaurant are operating at a deficit. Despite that we remain financially stable.

Catherine Bertrand-Vachet (*VP Finance*) moved to adopt the MCSS Budget 22-23 as presented, Henry Lee (*VP Comm. & Student Life*) seconded Unanimous, carried.

## 3.2 Proposal for Changes in MCSS Executive Positions and Structure

Define Helvacioglu (*President*) presented <u>Proposal for MCSS Exec Position Changes</u>
We would be restructuring the executive positions going from 10 Execs to 6. This involves a redistribution of duties that is more balanced. As well, we would make them paid by honorarium (hourly rate at minimum wage set by the Quebec government). We would use an app to track work hours. This is all in an effort to make participation in student council more accessible to those who also need to work while in school. If the proposal is adopted by Council, the next step will be to write a referendum question for adoption by Council and approval from the Deputy Provost.

A discussion followed: Concerns about transparency of hours claimed, monthly reports will be required. Overseen by VP Finance and President.

Define Helvacioglu (*President*) moved to adopt the MCSS executive Positions and Structure proposal as presented, Henry Lee (*VP Comm. & Student Life*) seconded Unanimous, carried.
