3.2 Updates from January Faculty Meeting (Informational)

Henry Lee (President): Construction Update:

- -Raymond roof repair not completed, which causes delays in reopening the building.
- -Mac Stewart basement affected by the flood is accessible except for MSB-016.
- -Mobile classrooms should be completed by Feb 2024
- -Parasitology and MS labs projects are on track.
- -New building at Mac on hold for now.

<u>Hiring Freeze</u>: The Quebec government new policy on the tuition fee increase, is affecting the university's finances long term, resulting in cuts for the faculty such as early retirement for professors. It will also apply to hiring of students and intramural sports.

New French-Language Requirements:

English universities will now require having 80 per cent of non-Quebec students attending English universities to reach level 6 in French proficiency by graduation. Students won't be prevented from graduating, but the university will be fined if they fall short.
